## **Fall Ball**

There will be an optional tournament on the weekend of Oct. 18<sup>th</sup>. The cost of the tournament will be \$150.00 with a 3 game guarantee. (The rainout date for the league will be Oct. 18<sup>th</sup> if that is needed the tournament will be played on Oct. 24<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup>).

Roger Delawder submitted his resignation from the board effect July 19<sup>th</sup>. He will be moving out of state.
